

NIC Sponsors U.S. Pavilion in 2010 India Nuclear Energy Expo

The India Market Working Group of the U.S. Nuclear Infrastructure Council, in conjunction with the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce, coordinated a 70-square meter U.S. pavilion representing their member organizations and U.S.-affiliated nuclear organizations at India's largest nuclear expo held October 7-9, 2010 in the Bombay Exhibition Center, Mumbai.

In addition to the Expo, the Department of Atomic Energy of India hosted a Nuclear Summit on October 8th and NIC members GE and Westinghouse sponsored an exhibitor reception on October 7th. The U.S. Consul General was also on hand to give a private dinner on October 8th celebrating the 2-year anniversary of the Indo-U.S. Civil Nuclear Agreement.

The India Nuclear Energy Expo put on display the emerging role of nuclear energy and the opportunity for investment in nuclear energy in the economic development of India in the 21st century. NIC's participation in the event highlights its understanding of energy needs as transcending borders and the international opportunities in pursuing nuclear energy technology.
