

NIC Co-Hosts Briefing on Japan's Nuclear-Related Events

On Tuesday, March 22nd, NIC co-hosted a webcast briefing, along with Edison Welding Institute, on developments related to quake and tsunami damage to the Fukushima-Daiichi nuclear power station in Japan.

The panel of experts included David Blee, Executive Director of the U.S. Nuclear Infrastructure Council, Lake Barrett, Former Deputy Director of the Office of Civilian Radioactive Waste Management, Marc Goldsmith, Principal of MGC LLC and Former Vice President of Stone & Webster, Edward Davis, Former President of the American Nuclear Energy Council, Dan Yurman, American Nuclear Society, and Nate Ames, Director of the Nuclear Fabrication Consortium.

During the webcast, the panel provided a technical overview of the Fukushima Daiichi plant, current updates to new developments and on-going activities at the site, and the implications and perspectives on new nuclear build in the United States.
